## About Ronald McDonald House Charities South East Queensland

Ronald McDonald House Charities South East Queensland provides essential accommodation and support services to seriously ill children and their families who require treatment at specialist facilities in Brisbane and on the Gold Coast.

Most families tell us that it isn't just having a safe place to stay, it's all the extra things that make it a real home away from home. The comfort of a hot cuppa or a shoulder to cry on with our staff after a hard day at the hospital. It's a home-cooked meal so they don't have to worry about dinner. It's the special treats from the pantry and entertaining activity kits for the kids. It's catching up on lost weeks or months at school by having access to a tutor. And at the end of the day it's the comfort of a warm bed or soft pillow to close their eyes; even for a moment.

## Programs

- **Ronald McDonald Houses (RMH):** RMHC SEQ currently has three Houses in Brisbane; one at Herston adjacent to the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital, one at South Brisbane directly opposite the Queensland Children's Hospital (QCH) and Mater Mothers' Hospital (MMH) and a House inside the QCH, specifically to support patients of the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit. Each year we accommodate thousands of families in our Houses.
- **Ronald McDonald Family Room:** There are Ronald McDonald Family Rooms located inside the Gold Coast University Hospital (two Family Rooms) and QCH (one Family Room).
- **Ronald McDonald Learning Program:** The Program, assists school-aged children with serious illnesses and injuries to catch up on missed education following treatment and recovery.
